PARKING

The Management Board is receiving complaints about parking violations within the community.

- When parking a vehicle, it needs to not block or partially block community sidewalks. Pedestrians should not have to leave the sidewalk to walk in the road to get around parked vehicles.
- We want to remind you not to park on the roads or have service trucks inhibiting Providence City garbage trucks as this creates problems collecting garbage.
- If you or a guest are parking overnight in the visitor parking, you need to fill out and display an orange parking permit in the window of the vehicle. The permits are in the clubhouse above the suggestion box on the wall beside the front door on the wall.
